Sarah T. Hughes Scholarship Application

The Sarah T. Hughes Scholarship has been established by the Dallas Bar Foundation to enable minority men and women to have the opportunity to obtain a legal education at Southern Methodist University Dedman School of Law.

Judge Sarah T. Hughes devoted herself to improving the rights of women and minorities for more than half a century. She served in the Texas Legislature from 1930 to 1934 and was the first woman to become a State District Judge in Texas. Judge Hughes was appointed United States District Judge in 1962 by President John F. Kennedy and served until her retirement at the age of 85. Judge Hughes gained national recognition when she swore in Lyndon Baines Johnson as President of the United States on Air Force One after the assassination of President John F. Kennedy.

Funds for the Hughes Scholarship are raised on an annual basis. Every year the Dallas Bar Association's Bar None variety show is held in June. Since 1985, Bar None has contributed more than \$1,900,000 in scholarship money from their musical show starring attorneys, judges, paralegals and law clerks. Law firms, solo practitioners and individual donors provide financial support to the production and the scholarships. In 2011, the Dallas Bar Foundation initiated an additional fundraising event, *An Evening With...*, to supplement the proceeds from Bar None in support of the Hughes scholarship.

- 2. Submit a 500 word essay describing what impact the Sarah T. Hughes Scholarship will have on your educational and career goals.
